<p>Financial need considers all Financial Aid, scholarships, and VA Funding. Committee is specifically reviewing to see if tuition and books are covered for the semester. The goal is to award the highest points to those students with the least hours remaining in their degree program. This scholarship does not pay for courses that are NOT in the degree plan. Students that have already obtained a degree are NOT eligible for this scholarship. Eligibility is limited to 8 semesters of award with maximum hours at 63 credit hours.</p>	<p>Diversity Focus- applicants receive more credit if they are part of a multiple diversity scholarship categories.</p>	<p>Nonweighted High School GPA or College GPA after first graded college semester</p>
