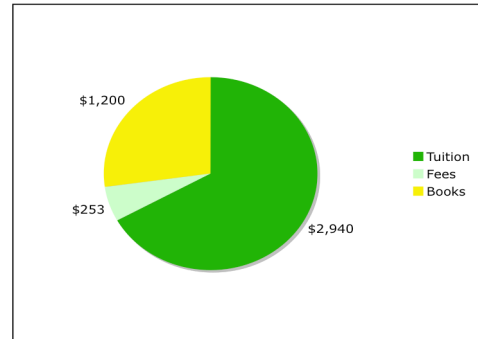

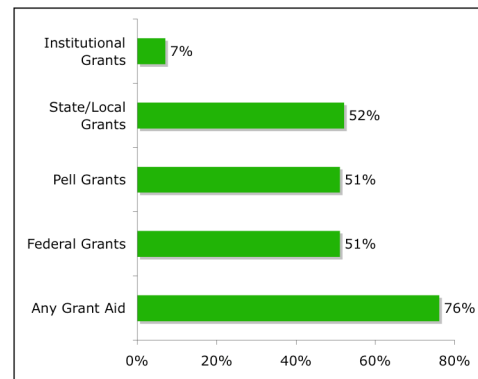

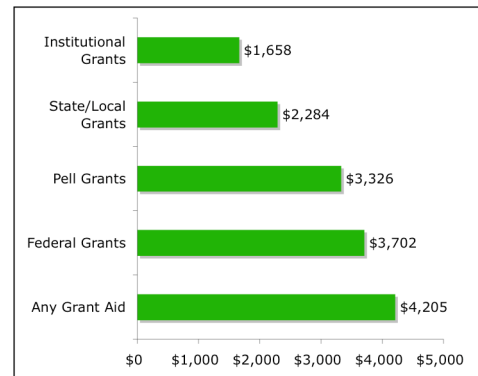
Average Cost of Attendance per Year 2010-2011



Percent of Full-Time First-Time Students Receiving Financial Aid By Type 2008-2009



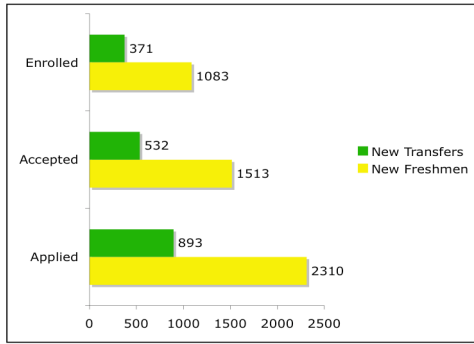
Average Amount of Financial Aid By Type 2008-2009

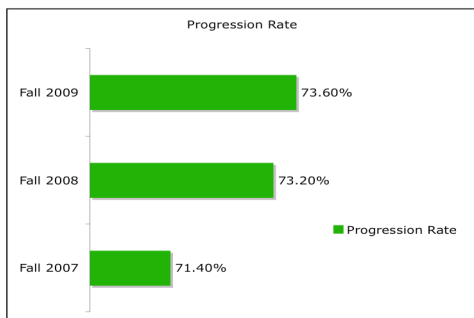


Median ACT Scores for Entering Freshmen 2009-2010

Represents the percentage of students that were enrolled in the fall who either graduated at the end of the fall or were enrolled in the following spring.

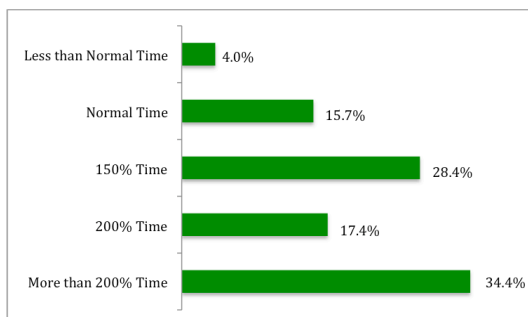

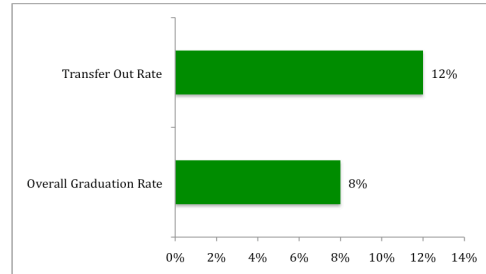
**Time to Graduation for Students Taking Developmental Studies Courses 2010 Graduates

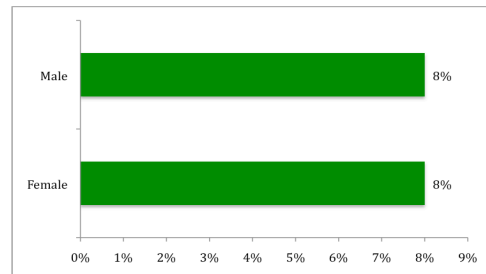
IPEDS "Student Right to Know" Graduation and Transfer-Out Rates Fall 2006 Cohort

The following statistics are based on IPEDS "Student Right to Know" statistics. They reflect graduation and transfer-out rates for students who began their studies in Fall 2006

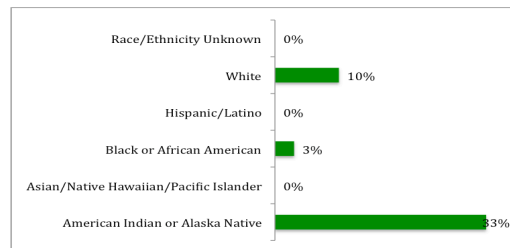
Students Who Graduated or Transferred Out Within 150% of Normal Time to Completion



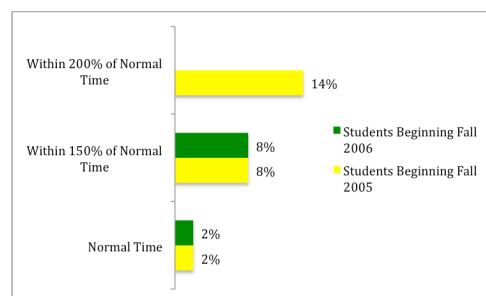
Students Who Graduated Within 150% of Normal Time by Gender
