

SGA Meeting

November 18, 2009

Call to Order: Chelsea called the meeting to order at 1:00 PM.

Introduction of Guest:

TBR Banner Representative—Bud Hoffman—Informed the group about the problems that have been caused with the new fees that took over this semester. Banner didn't calculate refunds and fees properly during the 25% to 75% refund period and with those doing course swaps. It refunded too much money to some while not refunding enough to others. For those who are getting a refund the refunds were sent out this past week. If anyone owes they were informed and have to pay the money back before they get their final grades, transcripts or are allowed to register for next semester. Any questions are to be referred to the business office.

Tennessee Donor Services—Ken Walton—Ken talked to us about the services that are offered through the TN Donor services. He talked about the educational opportunities to help spread the education about organ donation to help make an educated decision about organ donor. Lisa invited Ken to come set up at the Alcohol Awareness in April. Tennessee has set up their own registrar online within the last two years.

Announcements:

Activity Report:

Old Business:

- ❖ Chelsea covered the winners of the Miss JSCC pageant along with an update on Kiara who got sick at the pageant. She asked if anyone knows anyone who videotaped the pageant please let her know. Brandon's bill about the size and location of billboards passed both the house and senate. Chelsea's bill was picked as a random bill to discuss and passed the House but ran out of time to reach the senate. Time ran out before Candice's bill was brought up.
