○ Proposals

- Brandon brought 2 proposals to SGA.

- SGA voting booth

- The awareness of voting has falling off in the past few years since being moved to JWeb. Brandon brought statistics about the voting and showed the drop off. In the Fall of 2008, there were 1268 ballots cast out of 4381 enrolled. In the Fall of 2010 there were only 35 ballots cast out of 5363 enrolled. Brandon emphasized that voting is an important part of the awareness of the SGA. Brandon suggested that JSCC stop online voting and setup voting booths in several places around campus. Mr. Bobby commented that one of the reasons for going online was to try and stop duplicate ballots. He still suggested that this was a great idea because of the variance in enrolled students and the recent number of ballots cast. Brandon commented that a lot of the students don't even know that there are elections going on. Mike suggested having a print out of all students J numbers in class and use the print out to cast the ballots. Brandon presented a list of instructors that had previously turned in ballots. Mike called for a vote and passed.

- Consideration for Student Reps

- Brandon made the proposal for students that are representing JSCC off campus to get extra consideration for assignments. Athletics are given special privileges when they are away for ballgames. If all student representatives were allowed this then it would be equal across the board. Brandon proposed to have it stated on the instructors syllabus. Jordan made comment that there would need to be proof that the student was representing JSCC. Brandon suggested the travel form as a possible proof. Brian called for a vote and it passed.
