

S.G.A. Minutes  
7-1-2011

-Meeting called to order at 1:05pm.

-Attendance: President Brandon McArthur, President-Elect Mike Moorman, Vice President Adam Bishop, Vice President-Elect Chris Mugabi, Secretary/Treasurer Brian McDonald (arrived 1:38pm), Sophomore Senator Montee Lopez, Sophomore Senator-Elect Ricky Blanton, Sophomore Senator-Elect Martin Rodriguez, Lisa Kincaid and Steve Cornelison (arrived 1:07pm). Absent was Sophomore Senator-Elect Natasha Puente.

- Old Business: Open Mic Night will continue as planned. A suggestion had been made that a karaoke night should take its place. The suggestion was opposed.
- President Elect Mike Moorman brought Senator Montee Lopez up to speed on the last meeting where it was decided that a different event would take the place of the Miss JSCC pageant from now on.
- The second draft of the General Journal was introduced to the persons in attendance. It met with informal approval.
- New Business:Lisa Kincaid put forward 2 new budget requests. It was determined that a budget request form needs to be completed for each event to which funds are to be allocated.
- The first request was for a computerized interactive game show system for the entire school at a total cost of \$1,500. A vote was taken and the measure passed unanimously.
- The second request was for new interchangeable volleyball equipment for the campus. The total cost is \$1,774.95. A vote was taken and the measure passed, one opposed.
- Vice President Adam Bishop, President-Elect Mike Moorman, and Vice President-Elect Christopher Mugabi have all yet to submit a schedule for summer office hours.
- An announcement was made to the persons in attendance that a volleyball tournament would take place towards the end of July.
- Handbook changes were submitted to SGA for approval.

- President-Elect Moorman pointed out that the handbook mandates office hours during the summer. The matter was discussed. Vice President Bishop suggested that officers encountering other obligations or officers who happen to be spring graduates have the one time beginning-of-the-summer option to resigning their post and having their oaths fulfilled in doing so. President Brandon McArthur and Vice President Bishop compromised that if an officer has summer courses on campus or otherwise, they would be required to fulfill summer office hours. If they have no summer class, they are exempt from those hours.
- It was then proposed that hours be made optional to all officers, and that meetings be held more frequently over the summer. This increase would be from 1 meeting per month to 2. This measure was voted upon and passed.
- The next item on the agenda was that of the office printer. It was determined that the printer would be for use by SGA officers only, and only for SGA related tasks.
- President Brandon McArthur stated that office hour forms would be undergoing changes to add columns for extra or unscheduled hours.
- It was determined that Freshman Senators would be tasked with maintaining the SGA board.
- It was proposed that the meeting be extended by 30 minutes. The measure passed.
- In the interest of time, and given that everyone in attendance was to read and claimed to have read the proposed handbook changes on their own time, it was proposed that a vote pertaining to the full bulk of changes be taken. This measure was seconded, the vote for the bulk changes was taken, and all of the changes were passed.
- SGA Advisor Steve Cornelison brought it to the attention of SGA that parking violation appeals would now be referred to SGA, and then back to Steve for his approval, then back to the SGA if there were any objections to SGA's rulings.
- Again it was suggested that community service be offered as an option to students found guilty of parking violations. Questions were posed as to who would oversee this service and how it would be supervised. Vice President Bishop volunteered to draft a new bill by the following Wednesday to formally propose this option.
- The meeting was adjourned at 2:30pm.
