Call to Order: Chelsea called the meeting to order at 01:06 PM

Minutes: James Fowler read the minutes from previous meeting. Mary Stiddom made the motion to approve and Jessica Weatherspoon seconded the motion, minutes were approved.

Committee Reports:

Chelsea gave an overview of the SPEC committee meeting she attended with the highlight being that they had discussed a new mission statement for JSCC. They presented a couple of ideas and then were to vote online. It would then be sent for approval.

Chelsea also is working on getting to become a non-voting member of Mary Stiddom on the Curriculum Committee.

Old Business:
