-President McArthur called the meeting to order at 1:40pm.

-The President read a memo to SGA detailing his disappointment with the pacing of the previous meeting, and outlining how we could all overcome this problem in the future.

-Vice President Bishop read the minutes from the previous meeting.

-Volunteers are requested for a Night at the Generals at Pringles Park.

-A call for participation was issued in order to make Temple Grandin day a success.

-A measure was proposed to formalize the process of appealing parking citations. The issue would essentially still be SGA responsibility, but final approval would have to come from staff and faculty. SGA voted on the measure and unanimously approved it.

-The new format for SGA election ballots was informally reviewed and informally approved of by SGA.

-The prospect of a TBR student representative and the accompanying interview for that position were discussed. The interviewing is to be conducted on 3-26-2011.

-SGA signed a card thanking the person who loaned her vehicle to Miss JSCC and SGA for her generosity.
