

Dual Credit

A JSCC course that is taught at the high school by the high school instructor for high school credit but the students are able to receive JSCC credit by successfully completing the course plus passing the assessments that are required by JSCC. Once the student enrolls at JSCC, the credit is placed on the JSCC transcript. The school must have a Dual Credit Agreement with JSCC and the student must fill out an application and meet requirements to qualify.

- Student must have at least a 2.0 overall GPA

Dual Enrollment

A JSCC course that is taught either at the high school or at JSCC by JSCC Faculty (may be adjunct) or by the high school faculty that meet SACS credentials. Upon successful completion of the course, the student earns JSCC and high school credit. The student must meet dual enrollment eligibility and must be a Junior or Senior in high school. Most students are eligible for the Tennessee Education Dual Enrollment Lottery Program which pays \$300 of the tuition per semester. The school must have a Dual Enrollment agreement and contract with JSCC in order for students to participate.

- Student must have at least a 3.0 overall GPA
- Student must have a 19 in the subject area on the PLAN or ACT (for example: 19 in English and Reading on the PLAN or ACT in order to take English for Dual Enrollment)
