

## Non-Traditional Lottery Students

This is a rule that was passed during the Summer of 2008.

The criteria are as follows:

- Must be a TN resident for at least one year prior to application
- Must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year
- The application deadline for Fall is September 1<sup>st</sup> and for Spring/Summer is February 1<sup>st</sup>
- Must be 25 years of age or older before beginning college enrollment
- Must have an Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of \$36,000 or less on the tax return (this will be verified each year)
- Must have been an incoming freshman or have not been enrolled in the last two years before enrolling at JSCC as a non-traditional student
- Must be enrolled in a degree-seeking major at an eligible post-secondary institution
- Must attempt 12 hours earning a 2.75 lottery GPA before can be determined as eligible for the scholarship
- The maximum award for this scholarship at a 2 year institution is \$2000 per year based on full-time enrollment
- Must be continuously enrolled (defined as enrolled each Fall and Spring semesters)
- Once accepted in the program, students must comply with the same rules as the other Lottery students
