All requested information is provided as requested and in the format outlined in the application.</p> <p>Note: If applicant has less than 30 college credit hours, a copy of the high school transcript is required. If applicant completed a GED and has less than 30 college credit hours, a copy of GED score is required</p>	10
Coursework	<p>Point values: A-5 points, B- 3 points, C-1 point, Not taken- 0 points</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Anatomy and Physiology I-completion required for admission points_____ • ENGL 1010 points_____ • PSYC 1030 points_____ • SPCH 1010 points_____ • Humanities Elective points_____ 	25
Grade Point Average	<p>A cumulative GPA will be calculated from student’s GPA history and will be based upon transcripts from all prior colleges/universities.</p> <p>If the applicant has less than 30 college credit hours, high school GPA or GED GPA equivalent will be included in cumulative GPA.</p>	40
Resume	<p>Submitted resume follows the provided outline and includes candidate’s areas of interest as well as employment history. Candidate may highlight special skills or experiences that might set him/her apart from others. Resume is typed</p>	5
Observation Hours	<p>A <u>minimum</u> of 8 Observation hours required with an OTA/OT, and signed by the OTA/OT</p>	10
