## **How to Provide 2022 Tax Return Information**

## I. For those who filed a 2022 Tax Return: Select one of the options below.

(Non-Tax Filers please skip to Section II.)

- a) Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool
  - Log into the FAFSA at <a href="www.fafsa.gov">www.fafsa.gov</a> and use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to download your 2022 tax return information directly to the FAFSA.
- b) If you filed taxes using an online platform (*Examples: IRS.gov, or Turbo Tax*), you can log into your account to print a copy. You must sign the copy before you send it to the Financial Aid Office.
- c) If you file taxes using a preparer (*Example: H&R Block*), you can ask your preparer for a copy. *You must sign the copy before you send it to the Financial Aid Office*.
- d) Order IRS Tax Return Transcript online or by mail.
  - Go to https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript
  - Scroll down, click the desired option and follow the instructions presented.

Mailed transcripts are sent to the last address on file with the IRS.
