Financial need considers all financial assistance which is applied to the JSCC student account. Students with zero Unmet financial need determined by Financial Aid will get zero points for need.	For retention- use the degree works proposal for hours remaining toward degree program. The goal is to award the highest points to those students with the least hours remaining in their degree program. This scholarship is only for courses that are required for a degree. Students with a degree (Associate or higher) are NOT eligible for this scholarship. Eligibility is limited to 8 semesters of award with maximum hours at 63 credit hours.
