Types of Financial Aid Available at JSCC

<u>*Grants*</u> – financial aid that typically does not have to be repaid, usually based on income and/or financial need – called "need-based"

- Federal grants:
 - Federal Pell Grant apply each year using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) – <u>www.fafsa.gov</u>
 - Federal Supplemental Education Opportunity Grant (SEOG) apply using the FAFSA, funds are limited, so apply early. Per federal regulations, only students eligible for the Pell Grant are able to receive SEOG funds.
- State grants:
 - Tennessee Student Assistance Award (TSAA) Provides non-repayable financial assistance to financially needy undergraduate students who are residents of Tennessee - apply using the FAFSA – funds are limited, so apply early.  - Helping Heroes Grant has an online application with the Tennessee Student Assistance Corporation – for U.S. veterans who were honorably discharged or who are a former or current member of a reserve or TN National Guard Unit – funds are limited, so apply early. More information may be found at <u>Tennessee Financial Aid - College for TN</u>
 - TN HOPE Foster Child Tuition Grant awarded to students who were in custody of the Dept. of Children's Services for at least one (1) year after reaching the age of fourteen (14) – recipients are identified through the Department of Children's Services. <u>Scholarships</u> - financial aid that does not typically have to be repaid, based on educational criteria, called "merit-based"

- Institutional (JSCC) scholarships:

<u>Student Employment Programs</u> – these are referred to as "self-help" because the student is working hours for pay

- Institutional Work Program non-need based employment, application is the FAFSA and there is also an additional application found at <u>https://www.jscc.edu/financial-aid/types-of-aid/employment.html</u>

Loans - also referred to as "self-help" but is money which will require repayment
